Kol Ami: The Northern Virginia Reconstructionist Community is looking for a part-time Tot Shabbat Coordinator to develop and host monthly Tot Shabbat programming for toddlers through preschoolers accompanied by a parent.

Responsibilities include

- **Develop a curriculum** for monthly Shabbat morning programming to coincide with adult services. Curriculum should include music, storytelling and Jewish identity building that is also welcoming to interfaith couples.
- **Lead monthly** Tot Shabbat services that foster a Jewish identity and initial familiarity with Jewish customs and prayers in a fun and welcoming environment.
- **Coordinate with Kol Ami's Rabbi** to schedule Tot Shabbats to coincide with adult services, and integrate the tots and parents into the conclusion of the adult service.
- **Marketing & Outreach:** A successful Coordinator will reach out to local families in the community and increase engagement and attendance over the coming year.
- **Coordinate with Kol Ami's Jewish Children's Education Program (JCEP)** alerting the JCEP Coordinator about families with children that might be interested in graduating to the school-age program.
- **Report to Kol Ami's President** and stay in close contact on successes and challenges of the Tot Shabbat Program.
